### FULL BIO

Ariella Zeitlin is an internationally recognized violinist, celebrated for her groundbreaking performances that weave together music, mindset, and meaning in a way that captivates audiences worldwide.

A Baltimore native, Ariella's prodigious talent was recognized early when she was accepted into the prestigious Peabody Institute at the age of just eight, launching her solo career under the mentorship of the renowned Mellasenah Edwards. By ten, she was already performing with orchestras, and at thirteen, embarked on her first international tour to Japan.

At seventeen, Ariella moved to Israel to study with the country's foremost violin pedagogues, gaining swift acceptance to the esteemed Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance. Under the rigorous tutelage of Michael Gaisler, she distinguished herself by winning numerous competitions both nationally and internationally.

Among hundreds of candidates, Ariella was selected to attend the distinguished Music Academy of the West in Montecito, California, in 2009. The following year, she was honored with an invitation to the prestigious Perlman Music Program in Jerusalem, representing the Jerusalem Academy. Throughout her studies, Ariella earned numerous awards and scholarships, a testament to her exceptional artistry and dedication.

In 2011, she was awarded the highly competitive America-Israel Cultural Foundation Prize to pursue her Master of Music degree. Her growing reputation led to performances across Israel, where she captivated audiences in premier recital halls. After completing her M. Mus. in 2013, she was immediately flown to London by the World Zionist Organization to perform for hundreds at their "Night to Honor Israel," earning a standing ovation.

Ariella continued to build her distinguished career, returning to Jerusalem to perform and teach. Among her many memorable performances was an inspiring rendition of Mendelssohn's Violin Concerto while nine months pregnant with her second child. In November 2014, she was flown to Toronto to headline a gala for Yad Vashem, where \$2.6 million was raised for Holocaust education.

Since 2015, Ariella has performed as a sought-after solo artist across more than 20 countries. Her debut album, Revelation, was awarded the Israel Ministry of Culture Prize, cementing her reputation as a performer whose work transcends entertainment to educate, uplift, and inspire audiences around the globe.
